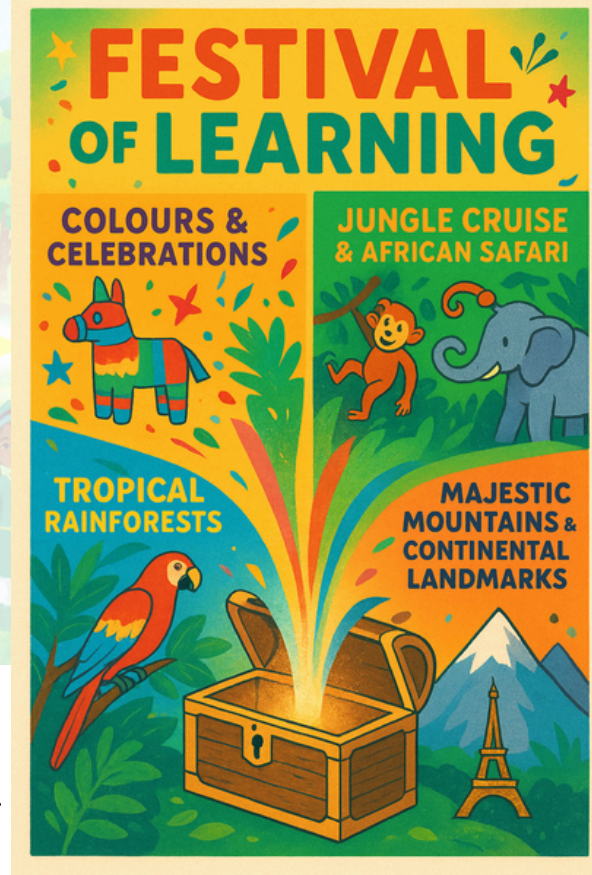
Dear Sunnydale School Families,

Happy & Healthy: Fruit and Water Wednesday



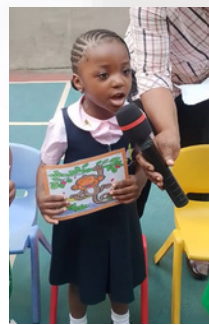
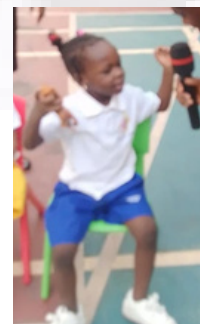

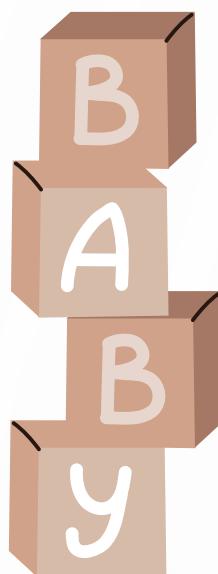
