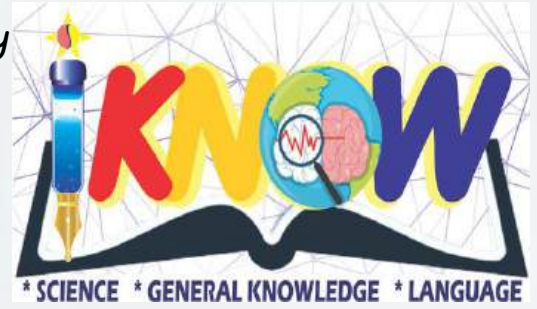

Co-Curricular Activities

Buddy Meetings

Every Friday morning, we hold buddy sessions. We believe children's emotional and social well-being is just as important as their academic growth. Staff members meet with their small buddy groups to talk about topics like responsibility, teamwork, bullying, and leadership. These sessions have been very rewarding, and the children truly look forward to that safe, supportive time together on Friday mornings.



IXL - Continuous Practice Platform

IXL is an online learning platform which gives each child a personalised path to growth. It offers continuous, step-by-step practice based on international curriculums. The school pays for the annual subscription, and Year Six children are signed up at subsidised rates. IXL is suitable for children from Reception to Year 12, with plenty of practice questions and clear explanations to help them learn, revisit, and master concepts.
